



## February 2018 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) Amendment

Project: State Route (SR) 432 Cowlitz River Bridge Painting  
Agency Requesting  
RTIP Amendment: Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT)-Southwest Region

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The primary purpose of the RTIP is to identify and document federally funded transportation projects that are to be included in the Washington State Department of Transportation's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Amendments are substantial changes to projects lying within the jurisdiction of the Longview-Kelso-Rainier Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and which require action by the CWCOG Board of Directors.

As the MPO, the CWCOG is required to develop a financially constrained RTIP. The requirements for the RTIP are established in federal law. The RTIP is a four-year program of transportation projects which have secured federal funding, as well as those that are regionally significant. The RTIP indicates commitment for funding of these projects. The RTIP is developed through a cooperative and coordinated prioritization process involving local jurisdictions, the Washington State Department of Transportation, the CWCOG staff, and the CWCOG Board, as the MPO policy board.

This project has secured, federal Surface Transportation Program funding for construction that is scheduled to begin in 2018. The total project cost estimate has increased about 48% from \$2,730,000 to \$4,060,000. A copy of the project's record in the Washington Statewide Transportation Improvement Program database is attached.
